



CorkSport Mazdaspeed 3 Front Bumper Install Instructions

Tools Required

- Phillips Head Screw Driver
- 10mm Socket ¹/₄" or 3/8" Drive
- ½" or 3/8" Drive Ratchet
- Drill Electric or Cordless
- 3/16" Drill Bit

- Pop Rivet Tool
- Floor Jack
- Jack Stands
- Safety Glasses

- 1 CorkSport Front Bumper
- 2 3/16" Diameter ½" Long Pop Rivets
- 4 x Quick Cure Epoxy (only with screens)
- 1 FRP Center Panel
- 11 Page Installation Instructions

NOTE: CorkSport recommends that the bumper is test fit prior to any painting or finishing work being done. It is also recommended that this bumper be installed by a certified paint and body shop. Installation of this bumper will take approximately one hour.

NOTE: Some body work and trimming to bumper may be required for exact fitment.

WARNING: Follow the instructions for your jack and jack stands or serious injury or death may occur.

Step 1: Jack up front of vehicle and place securely on jack stands. Remove both front wheels and tires.

Step 2: With hood open, remove four (4) plastic Phillips head clips from I/C ducting to core support. Remove four (4) more plastic Phillips head clips from ducting to bumper and remove ducting from vehicle.



Step 3: Remove two (2) plastic Phillips head clips and two (2) Phillips head screws from each corner of top of bumper.



Step 4: Remove four (4) plastic Phillips head clips (two on each side) from inner fender liner to bumper.



Step 5: Remove five (5) Phillips head screws from under tray to front of bumper. Remove six (6) Phillips head screws (three on each side) from fender liner to bumper.

Step 6: Remove seven (7) 10mm head bolts from under tray and remove under tray.

Step 7: Unplug wire harness from both front driving lights and unclip their harness clips from bumper.



Step 8: Remove one (1) Phillips head screw from air temp. sensor bracket to bumper. Unclip wire harness clips from bumper and position assembly out of your way.



Step 9: While pulling inner fender liner back, remove the Phillips head screws from the corners of the bumper to the fender.



Step 10: Pull up on the clips from behind the grill area from the crash bar and remove bumper.



Step 11: Install the original I/C ducting to the CorkSport bumper using the four (4) original Phillips head plastic clips.



Step 11: Install bumper onto MS3.

WARNING: While installing bumper, watch fitment to head lights and fenders otherwise cracking or other damage to vehicle/bumper can occur.



Step 12: Reinstall four (4) original Phillips head plastic clips for the I/C ducting to core support.



Step 13: Reinstall the two (2) original Phillips head plastic clips and (2) Phillips head screws to both corners of the grill opening of the bumper.



Step 14: While pulling fender liners back, reinstall the two (2) original Phillips head screw (one on each side) to corners of bumper to fender.



Step 15: Reinstall four (4) original Phillips head plastic clips to fender liner to bumper.



Step 16: Reinstall six (6) original Phillips head screws (three on each side) to lower fender liner to bumper.

NOTE: The screws screw into the bumper.



Step 17: Reinstall the front section of under tray to bumper with the original five (5) Phillips head screws.

Step 18: Reinstall main under tray with original seven (7) 10mm head bolts.



Step 19: Install center FRP panel in between the I/C ducts. Using a 3/16" drill bit and drill, drill one hole on each side of the ducts and through the center panel. Insert supplied pop rivets through holes and pop rivet in place.

NOTE: Painting of this part should be done prior to permanent installation.



Step 20: Reinstall wheels and tires and remove vehicle from jack stands. Close hood and you are done.

WARNING: The bumper is approximately 2" lower then factory. Use caution when entering driveways or going over speed bumps as serious damage can occur to the bumper.
